On the above schedule of fees the maximum amount for each surgical procedure is determined and includes surgeon's fees, assistant's and anesthetist's fees, and the accomodation limits and doctors fees. Rest of charges will be settled based on the Reasonable and Customary expenses i.e. Theatre expenses and consumables. These fees are paid on condition that the surgical operation has taken place and the amounts due were paid.

For surgical operations not listed the amount for a surgical procedure of similar seriousness will be paid.

- If the hospitalization exceeds 9 days, attendance fee will not exceed €55.
- 2. The fee, for professional attendance daily fee in intensive care unit, will not exceed €155. These fees are valid for any day.
- For extremely serious operations the first 9 days are included in the surgeon's fee. More than nine days an attendance fee of €55 will be paid.
- 4. The treating doctor is determined by the symptoms and the diagnosis of the insured.
- 5. Attendance and accommodation fee will be determined by the number of nights an insured is hospitalized. For day patient 50% of the accommodation fee will be paid.
- 6. When a diagnostic/ investigative operation results in surgery then the most expensive one will be paid.
- 7. In case of operation the surgeon will be in charge for the post operative care in the hospital.
- 8. In case of more than one operation with the same incision and anesthesia the most expensive one will be paid. In case of different incision 30% of the second operation will be paid if enough medical evidence is submitted (i.e laparoscopy CD).
- 9. Disposable items, plates, screws etc must be charged according to the suppliers receipt which should be submitted
- Medication and disposables are charged based on reasonable and customary. Detailed analysis with quantities and pricing should be provided.

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
